He will return again in power and glory to draw all of his children together with songs of everlasting praise.

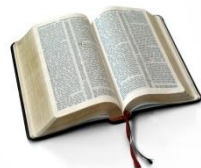
The promise of the baby is also the promise of eternal life to all who believe.

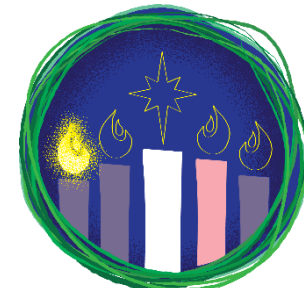
